Time is a strange thing. If you are waiting for something the seconds barely tick by. Molasses dripping is quicker, I am sure. See a long-lost friend and that time speeds by laser speed. C S Lewis, that wonderful author and theologian wrote about time. He said that we humans think in terms of past present and future. But, not so with God. God sees it all in one vision. I imagine it sort of life a telescopic lens. The angle is so much wider than anything that we can even imagine.

I was reminded of that kind of time this week. The fourteenth of August is the somber anniversary of the death of my older brother. For the life of me I could not remember how many years it has been. In one moment, it all seems like yesterday. In the next moment it all seems so very long ago. I push myself to remember his voice, his mannerisms, him. And just like that, some memory bubbles up as clear as day.

My grounding this week has come from that writing of C S Lewis. In my humanness I think of my brother in the past. He left this earth seven years ago. I miss him with every ounce of my being. I find comfort though knowing that God's time is not my time. My brother rests in God's hands. In Gods vision there is no separation. In Gods vision it is all one. I have not lost my brother back there in time. Rather because God holds us all in God's hands, no past no present no future, there is only wholeness and completes. I entrust my brother to that never failing, always present divine presence. I find peace and comfort in that sure knowledge. Still miss the guy who very day but my faith leads me to trust. In the words of that beloved prayer. I entrust hi to Gods safe keeping knowing that god is doing for him better things than I can even imagine.

Time certainly is strange.

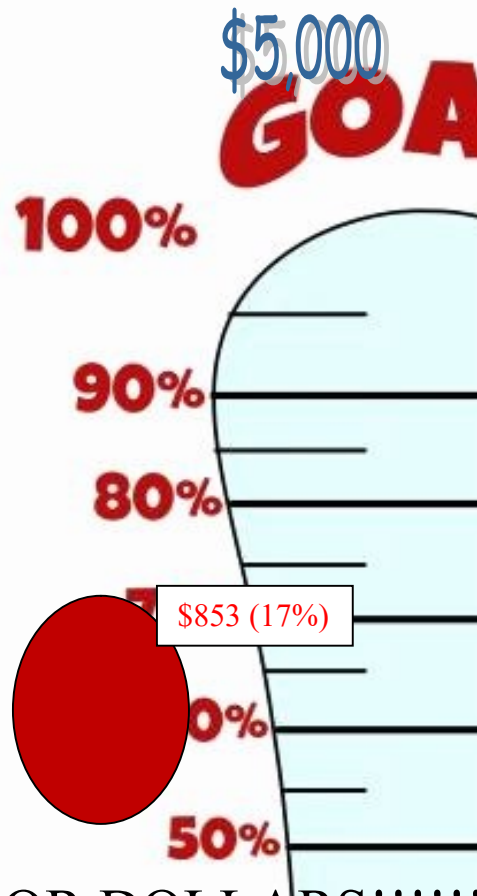
2024 STEWARDSHIP
